


RUNNING AN EXCEPTIONS REPORT

STEPS REQUIRED


Step 1:

From the main menu, click on the Rules and Groups tab on the left side of the page and click on Exceptions.



Step 2:


Click on the Options button at the top of the page.






Step 3:

- Input your requirements as below;
- Specify your date range
- Select whether you would like to run by vehicle or driver.
- Specify which vehicle/driver to run this report against or select all.
- Specify which rules you would like to report on. You can select individual rules or Select All.
- Select Apply Changes.



NOTE: When you select a vehicle, driver or rule the selected button will turn dark blue to indicate it has been selected.

NOTE: Safer Together rules are identified by the description ST as shown below.






Step 4:

Once loaded, a list will display with any exceptions captured specified in your search.



Step 5:


To export this data, click on the View button, select either Summary or Detailed option and then Report or Advanced.
